



### **GETTING THE 4-1-1 ON REVERSE 9-1-1**

Since 2001 the St. Lucie County Sheriff's Office has been utilizing a community emergency notification system known as Reverse 9-1-1. This system allows the Sheriff's Office to quickly notify thousands of residents, through a computer mapping program, of events such as a missing persons, crime trends, disaster or when a sexual offender moves in to a neighborhood.

The Reverse 9-1-1 System even allows us to keep our fingers on the pulse of the community by surveying neighborhoods to determine if our efforts are working.

Reverse 9-1-1 obtains telephone numbers through various public record sources. So if you have a published or listed phone number you will receive a telephone call from the system. Those who do not have a listed or published phone number will not unless they register their phone number with the Sheriff's Office. You can do so by visiting [www.stluciesheriff.com/reverse\\_911.php](http://www.stluciesheriff.com/reverse_911.php). It's simple and should you want to opt out in the future we will remove you from the system. By the way, we will never share your telephone number. Your telephone number is only used in conjunction with the Reverse 9-1-1 system.
